New Hampshire State & Local Specific Terms and Contract Clause

MISS NEW HAMPSHIRE ORGANIZATION LOCAL CONTRACT CLAUSE 5.

The Miss New Hampshire Scholarship Program, Inc. recognizes that the Miss America boilerplate contract contains many clauses that are not applicable to local titleholders, and many that are not applicable to our Miss New Hampshire State titleholder. Anywhere in the contract that uses the term “appearance,” generally, means only those community service events that local titleholders and Miss New Hampshire routinely participate in. In New Hampshire, we recognize that the vast majority of our local chapter funding comes from event-oriented fundraisers and not from corporate sponsors. No local program, sponsor, or titleholder may require the local titleholder to take time off from school or work to participate in any event. No local program, sponsor, or titleholder may require the local titleholder to perform any services for a corporate sponsor—if one exists. These are volunteer positions that afford the contestant an opportunity to volunteer in her community and state or for her platform, and to gain scholarship assistance for school or college.
